

DEPT. 3 – SWINE

Judging Day – Wednesday, week of the fair

Judging Location – Coliseum

Judging Time – 8:30 a.m.

Entry Limit - Only two (2) hogs may be weighed in on entry day and exhibited at the county fair

Additional Rules of Entry

- **Non-Terminal Show – All hogs not sold at M.A.S. will return home after fair**
- Stalls must be cleaned by 8:00 a.m. **daily** down to the concrete. Failure to comply could result in forfeiture of premium
- **Premise ID Number must be recorded with superintendent**
- All exhibitors must show their own animal in all judging events, including showmanship
- Stalls will be assigned by the Superintendent - Exhibitors may not make advanced reservations
- ALL EXHIBITORS must be certified in YOUTH for the QUALITY CARE OF ANIMALS (YQCA)
- Displays can be removed after 6:00 p.m. on Monday
- 1 family member must be in barn for animal release on Monday
- Grooming of any animal on fair property must only be done by exhibitor, parent, step-parent or legal guardian of the exhibitor, a brother, step-brother, sister, step-sister or any other junior fair exhibitor at the Sheboygan County Fair of the current exhibit year. Failure to follow this rule will result in disqualification and loss of premium.
- No paint, powder, adhesives or color enhancing product is allowed to be applied to the animals while on fairgrounds. Standard skin conditioners are allowed.
- Superintendents reserve the right to do the “White Towel/Glove Test”: Officials may wipe a pig with a white towel or glove to check for color transfer, such as black or white paint/polish before the show. If any color comes off the exhibitor will be sent to wash the pig off prior to entering the ring. The exhibitor may be monitored while washing the animal.
- No farm name apparel allowed in the show ring. (i.e. shirts, hats, belt buckles, towels, etc.)
- **Market Animal Sale (M.A.S.) will be held on Thursday at 7:15 pm during the fair**
 - Weigh-In: Tuesday of fair week 3:00-7:00 p.m. Sheboygan County Fair will have a representative to verify final weights. Superintendents will divide classes (based on sex and weight). If both market animals fall into the same weight class, exhibitor must then choose which animal will be judged.

CLASS A – MARKET HOGS

Additional Rules of Entry

- Market Hogs may be any breed or cross and may be either barrow or gilt
- Underweight market animals (under 230 lbs.) will NOT be eligible for champion or meat animal sale
