

2026 Sheboygan County Fair Farmerbud Showmanship Sponsored by the Sheboygan County Holstein Association

This is an excellent chance to get our youngsters started showing cattle. Farmerbud Showmanship will take place Saturday of the Sheboygan County Fair at 2 pm or immediately after the conclusion of the Open class, whichever is later. Rules are as follows:

- ☐ Calf must be born between June 15, 2026, and August 1, 2026. It may be either a heifer or bull calf of any breed.
- ☐ There will be three classes: 4 & 5-year-old kids as of January 1, 2026; 6 & 7 years old as of January 1, 2026; and 8 years old as of January 1, 2026.
- ☐ Each child must have their own calf to show. For example, if you have two kids in two different classes, you still need two calves.
- ☐ Calves must be at the Fairgrounds no later than 12:30 pm on Saturday and taken home immediately after the show. There will be no barn space available.
- ☐ Kids are not required to wear white clothing.
- ☐ Kids will be required to wear a hat, which will be handed out prior to the show.
- ☐ Calves do not need to be clipped.
- ☐ Awards will be given, but no cash prizes.
