

# DEPT. 105 – GOATS

**Entry Day** - Wednesday of fair week, 4 – 8 p.m.

**Judging Day** – Following the Junior show, Saturday of the fair

**Judging Location** – Coliseum

## **Additional Rules of Entry**

- Exhibitors will NOT be allowed to enter more than one item in any one lot number.
- Junior Fair exhibits cannot be shown in the Open classes.
- If an exhibitor does not need the space allotted to them (stall/pen), please notify the superintendent. These areas cannot be used for storage or display areas.
- Pens are to be cleaned during the hours of 10:00p.m. and 8:00a.m. They must be cleaned down to the cement at least once during the fair. Failure to comply could result in forfeiture of the premium.
- Superintendents must examine all goats before goats can be put in pens. Any goat that is placed into a pen before examination will then be disqualified.
- All exhibitors entered in open class may enter up to 4 animals. Numbers may be limited due to space available.
- All pens must have a hay feeder. Horse hay nets are not allowed.
- All exhibitors must secure their pen gates with a clasp or wire.
- Lots 1-5 in any class must have never freshened.
- Lots 6-9 may or may not have freshened this year.

## **GOVERNMENT MANDATED REQUIREMENTS**

By the Department of Agriculture

- One of the following official forms needed for identification:
  - Ear tag
  - Legible Tattoos – Breed association or registration tattoo with management number accompanied by registration papers in owner's name
  - USDA Approved Implanted Microchips (Must supply your own microchip reader)
- **Copies of all paper work which includes Scrapie ID and Premise ID must be in the Fair Office on or before entry deadline or you will be unable to show at the Fair. NO EXCEPTIONS**
