Entry Fee: \$25.00 per tractor / one wristband per driver
 Weigh In: Sheboygan County Fair Grounds, 229 Fairview Dr, Plymouth, WI.
 Enter pits – Use County E to Douglas DR.
 Scale Hours: 3:00 – 5:30 PM. Scale closes at 5:30 pm SHARP – NO EXCEPTIONS
 Prizes: 1st - \$100 2nd - \$75 3rd - \$60 4th - \$50 5th - \$40 6th - \$30

CLASS A	Up to 6,500 LBS.	56 PTO H.P. EST. LIMIT (NO TURBO)	4 MPH PACE
CLASS B	Up to 8,500 LBS.	73 PTO H.P. EST. LIMIT (NO TURBO)	4 MPH PACE
CLASS C - COMBO	Up to 10,500 LBS.	86 PTO H.P. EST. LIMIT (TURBO/1.63" INLET)	5 MPH PACE
	Up to 11,000 LBS.	86 PTO H.P. EST. LIMIT (NO TURBO)	5 MPH PACE
CLASS CC	Up to 11,500 LBS.	410 MAX. CUBIC INCH LIMIT (NO TURBO)	5 MPH PACE
CLASS D	Up to 13,500 LBS.	NO H.P. LIMIT (SINGLE TURBO PERMITTED)	8 MPH PACE
CLASS E - COMBO	Up to 13,000 LBS.	410 MAX. CU. IN. (SINGLE TURBO PERMITTED)	5 MPH PACE
	Up to 14,000 LBS.	NO CU. IN. LIMIT (NO TURBO PERMITTED)	5 MPH PACE
CLASS F	Up to 16,000 LBS.	NO H.P. LIMIT (TURBO / 2.31" INLET)	8 MPH PACE
CLASS G	Up to 14,500 LBS.	NO H.P. LIMIT (SINGLE TURBO PERMITTED)	11 MPH PACE

Hobby Farm Class Up to 7,800 lbs. 330 cu. in. max / 3200 rpm / turbo 2.4" inlet / stock core pump /
 Factory fueled, A Pumps or Simms-minemac are OK /
 18.4x38 max tire size / no cut tires / 20" max drawbar height
 Tractors **MUST** have engine side shields – **NO** exceptions

Hobby Open Class Up to 12,500 3,000 rpm max / 20" max drawbar height. Wheelie bars,
 Roll bar, Steel fly wheel or blanket and helmet required

Farm Class Rules

Classes A, B, C, CC, E & F

- Farm classes open to stock rpm, 2-wheel drive tractors / 1960 and newer
- No turbo's allowed in classes A, B or CC / Single turbo only in classes C, E & F
- Class B tractors with add on turbo must pull in class C
- 18.4 x 38 tire width and height limit in classes A, B & C
- 18" hitching device limit in classes A, B, C & CC
- 20" hitching device limit in classes E & F
- Hook point must be at least 18" behind the center of the rear axle / No floating drawbars
- All tractors must provide their own clevis or pulling eye
- No modified or lowered front axles in farm classes
- No engine side shields unless factory equipped
- No cut or modified tires in farm classes
- Factory rated stock engine RPM's – Throttles will be checked at weigh in

Classes D & G (13,500 lb. & 14,500 lb.) See next page

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Classes D & G (13,500 lb. & 14,500 lb.)

- **13,500** – 8 mph
- **14,500** – 11 mph

- 3000 rpm limit
- 20" drawbar height – at least 18" from center of rear axle to hook point
- Drawbars must be fixed (tight) in all directions – no floating drawbars
- Must have a pulling eye or clevis and you must be able to hook from the top – no "straight" clevises
- Weights must not stick out any further than 30" from front of tractor
- Top cut tires are OK – No front cut tires allowed
- Maximum rim diameter of 42 inches – no 46" tires allowed
- Factory fuel only – no secondary fuels or additives / water injection ok / P pump ok
- Any size Turbo OK / Single Turbo only
- Exhaust must be straight out - No rain caps or curved pipes
- Engine side shields are ok / No modified or lowered front axles
- Safety equipment recommended
